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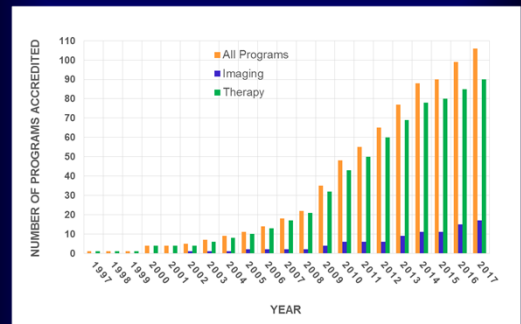
Current REPRC Activity

CAMPEP REPRC

- is responsible for the initial accreditation and re-accreditation of residency programs in medical physics.
- assigns a survey team which consists of senior medical physicists with experience in both clinical physics practice and education programs
 - ✓ volunteer based
 - ✓ 79 volunteers for self-study reviews and site visits (14 imaging, 12 physician reviewers)
