Recent Residency Accreditation History

- 2022: 6 new programs accredited
- 2023: 4 new programs accredited
- 2024: 11 new programs accredited
- 2025: 4 new programs accredited, 17 more in various stages of review

Program accreditation update

- All self studies from 2024 and earlier have review teams assigned
- Numerous new programs that submitted self studies in 2025 have review teams assigned
- 38 programs currently are in various stages of review
- 7 other new programs need review teams

New programs needing review teams

- Landauer IR (program is redoing application)
- WVU therapy
- Providence Cancer Institute therapy
- Precess Medical Derivatives therapy

- Accelerated Medical Physics Services therapy

2025 program reaccreditation update

- All through Apply system
- Some have have review teams assigned, the reviewers are all working through the Apply system
- Priority post AAPM is to have review teams assigned for the new programs and start working through the 2025 reaccreditations

Other REPRC issues

- Do we want to have a standard and official role for associate program director? Will update the language in standard to require the program to state who will take over if the program director cannot fulfill duties (ie-medical leave, etc)
- Should we edit the standard regarding steering committee meetings to state that it should have been organized and met prior to self study submission?- will update guidance language in self study template
