
Jonas D. Fontenot, PhD, DABR



Jonas Fontenot earned his undergraduate degree in Physics from the University of Louisiana-Lafayette in 2002. He went on to study Medical Physics at the University of Texas M. D. Anderson Cancer Center / Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences at Houston where he earned an M.S. and Ph.D. in 2005 and 2008, respectively. He then moved to Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, where he currently serves as Chief of Physics. He holds an adjunct faculty appointment in the Department of Physics and Astronomy at Louisiana State University (LSU), where he teaches a course in Advanced Radiation Therapy Physics and supervises student research in the Graduate Program in Medical and Health Physics. Dr. Fontenot has published 38 peer-reviewed papers and holds active research funding from industry sponsors and the National Cancer Institute. His research interests include development of tools for radiotherapy dose reconstruction and treatment delivery verification.
