On behalf of the Board of Directors of the Commission on Accreditation of Medical Physics Educational Programs (CAMPEP), I am pleased to inform you that the East Carolina University (MS) graduate program in Medical Physics has been granted accreditation through December 31, 2014. Although the Board considered a full, five-year accreditation, the Board is concerned about the staff turnover in clinical medicine. For these reasons, the Board feels that a three-year accreditation is appropriate. This accreditation is contingent upon completion of acceptable annual reports. Once adequate stability in medical physics and radiation oncology staff is demonstrated, consideration will be given to extend the accreditation for another two years.

Please accept our congratulations on the accreditation of your program. The report prepared by the review team appointed by the Graduate Education Program Review Committee is provided to you with this letter. This report offers some specific suggestions for improvement of the program which we hope will be implemented during this period of Accreditation. You are expected to provide annual progress reports on these suggestions and also to provide information regarding any substantive changes in the program.
